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#### 1. Call to Order

a. President Northcraft called the meeting to order at 6:34pm.

Kevin Northcraft announced the Board has concluded negotiations with the new owners of Re.Vive and noted the 10% monthly discount will apply until Evolutions re-opens.

Mooney also reported there is a lot of community support for a bond effort if it is in conjunction with grants. Mooney stated Adventist Health needs to inform the community just how heavily invested they are in Tulare.

- b. Transition Update Sandra Ormonde reported the gym is still closed and will not reopen until the State orders are lifted. Evo Management has applied for a second PPP loan and awaiting approval.

# 8. Adventist Health Tulare Update – Sheri Pereira, Site Administrator

Sheri Pereira reported the daily census is steady at 28; the first and second floors are open; hospital is providing urgent surgeries as of this week; residency program will begin this summer along with a dental residency; Orthopedic Associates is now a part of AH clinics and they will now be able to perform spine and joint surgeries; OB is steady; AH has started a recruitment for OB doctors; and vaccine clinics were available to employees. Sheri has informed Kaweah Delta and Sierra View Hospital in Porterville that Adventist Health Tulare has capacity to take Covid-19 patients.
