BE FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Tulare Local Healthcare District hereby authorizes its Interim Chief Operating Officer or its District's CFO to dispose of the surplus pharmaceuticals and pharmaceutical supplies through a fair market value sale of such surplus pharmaceuticals and pharmaceutical supplies by soliciting offers from purchasers and otherwise disposing of the surplus property in accordance with the requirements of California Health and Safety Code § 32121.2.
