

Argument in Favor of Measure H

Vote YES on Measure H to reopen our local emergency room and community hospital, and keep them open.

The closure of our only hospital left Tulare Local Healthcare District residents without access to the emergency and healthcare services they need. This closure also caused over 500 local jobs to disappear, and harmed the entire County's medical services. In an emergency, seconds count.
