Tulare (TU) is ranked among the least healthy counties in California (Lowest 0%-25%).

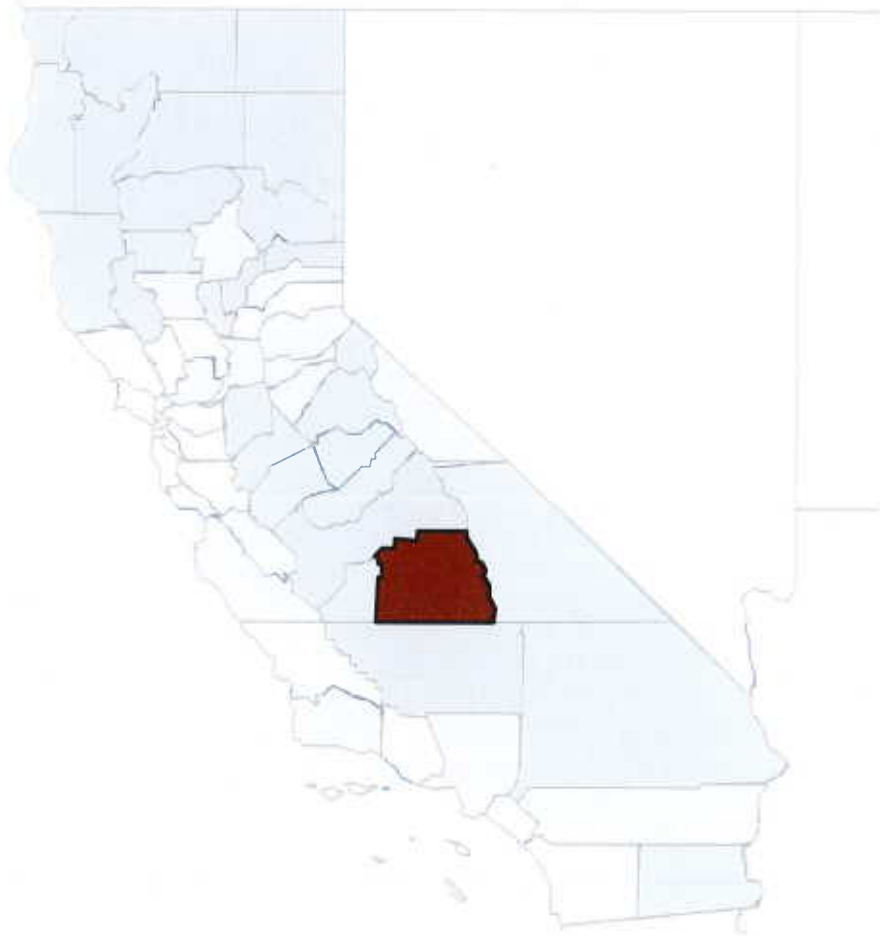


Health Factors
